Website Policy:

Website Visitors

Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using MG websites, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. MG will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, MG discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when MG believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of MG, third parties or the public at large. MG takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. MG uses cookies to help MG identify and track visitors, their usage of MG website, and their website access preferences. MG visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using MG websites, with the drawback that certain features of MG websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.
