DEAR FRIENDS,

In issuing our Fifth Annual Report we again express our deep gratitude to Him who has supplied all our needs, meeting every requirement as it has arisen, out of His glorious bounty, and enabling us once again to prove that His every promise is for those who put their trust in Him. Philippians IV., 19. Our Heavenly Father has again and again gloriously answered prayer, and not only in a general sense, but in specific details, providing in money, goods, and other requirements those things that have been definitely prayed and believed for.

There are now 39 children in the Homes, and when the two new houses adjoining our present ones are open (which will be the case before this report is in the hands of our friends), we shall have room for at least 60. We praise God for this further step He has led us to take, and feel confident that He will send the increased supplies that will be needed.

As will be seen by the accompanying Balance Sheet the income for the year (without in any way advertising or appealing to the public) has been £332: 13: 11 $\frac{1}{2}$, including £3: 1: 6, being the balance brought forward from last year. This amount does not include the gifts in kind and articles of clothing, which have been worth to us at least £50. Glory be to God. At the request of friends who do not wish their names to appear with the amount of their gifts, and to be more in accordance with the principles of a work of faith, we have decided not to publish the names of donors, but to issue a numbered receipt for each amount received, and to print a list showing the number and amount of every receipt given (which list will be found on the opposite page), so that donors can by comparing the numbers of their receipts with the same numbers in the list, recognise the entries of their donations. Will friends kindly see that they receive a numbered receipt for all money sent, bearing the stamp of the Home and the signature "H. W. White," to whom all gifts and donations should be sent,

It will be necessary to again state that the Home is mainly for destitute and motherless children, who are admitted after their case has undergone strict enquiries and we are well satisfied as to the genuineness of the need. Children are admitted without any sectarian distinction. Applications for admission are dealt with in the order in which they are received, orphans and motherless children having the preference.

The visiting hours for relatives and friends of the children are every Saturday between 6 and 8 p.m. (which time must be strictly adhered to unless special permission is obtained), and for visitors whom we shall be pleased to show over the Homes any afternoon between 3 and 5.

In place of the days which have usually been set apart for a sale of work, we feel led to have two days of prayer, praise and thanksgiving, which will be held this year on Saturday and Sunday, November 25th and 26th, Meetings at 3 and 6.30 p.m. on Saturday, and 11 a.m., 3 and 6.30 p.m. on Sunday, to which we cordially invite all friends interested in the work.

A full account of the Opening Meetings of our New Buildings will be found in our next report.

In closing we would again thank our many friends who have been used by God in supplying the needs of this His work during another year, and would ask for your continued prayers during the ensuing year with its added responsibilities. He is equal to them all.
